Of all the commandments, which is the most important? The most important one, answered Jesus, is this: "Hear, O Israel, the Lord our God, the Lord is one. With this statement, we join our brothers and sisters in the United Church of Christ who are like-minded in this declaration of love, justice, and mutual respect, with the example of Jesus' love as our guide.
